#### **Annual General Meeting**

Our Club AGM was held on Saturday with an outstanding turnout of members.

Following the normal protocols of our AGM, including one minute's silence for deceased members, the 2020 AGM Minutes were confirmed unanimously, as were the President's Annual Report (including the President's thanks to those members who have done so much for the Club), the Treasurer's Report & Financial Statements, and the Selector's Reports.

President Nigel Thompson asked members to consider taking on the roles of Greenkeeper, Bar Manager and/or membership of the Selection Committee.

Barry Baguley and John Mutch were each presented with BowlsVic Super Veteran badges, before the trophies for Season 2020/21 Club Championships were presented by President Nigel Thompson (see photos later in this Edition).

The election for available Board positions then proceeded, with Nigel Thompson & Vicky Walker re-elected and Don Leale & Paul Ives elected. Congratulations to each, and particularly to the new Board members Don and Paul.

Not surprisingly, most of the General Business focussed on COVID-19 and the recently published BowlsVic requirements (derived from State Government prescriptions). These requirements, strange as it may be, are based on a licensed Club's liquor licence "red line", and determine eligibility to practice and play. In the case of our Club, our Green is within our "red line". As a result, only fully vaxxed (or validly exempt) members (including visiting Club members) can play or practice at Aberfeldie. These prescriptions are subject to change, just as a number of other State Government COVID-19 requirements have.

Club Life Members then took the lead in "Opening the Green" for the Season.

Following the AGM, the new Board met and determined the following for Season 2021/22:
