Saturday Pennant – not such a good day

Pretty much a perfect day weatherwise on Saturday but it never delivered great fortune for us. Once again we were forced to play short in Aberfeldie 3.

Aberfeldie 1, playing Away at Doutta Galla, suffered a heartbreaking 1 shot loss (80-81 for 4 points). Rink results:

Sean Lee with Paul Ives, Bill Walshe & David Torkar – 19-20, never more than a couple of shots in it, but Doutta Galla wrapped up a 1 shot win when we lost 2 shots on the last end.

Joe Engert with Clay Beveridge, Michael Bialczak & Robin Stoddart – 23-15 after getting out early and keeping the challenge at bay when it came.

Ian Ferretter with Harry Bayer, Don Leale & Stuart O'Brien – 23-15 after getting out early and keeping the pressure on.

Manny Flores with Sam Folino, Gabriele Forlani & Murray Whiteway – 17-32 after falling behind early, never making inroads – and losing 15 shots on ends fourteen to eighteen.

Aberfeldie 2, playing at Home against Altona North took the win 59-48 for 14 points. Rink results:

Warwick Robinson with Fred Sinclair, Barry Baguley & Joe Scifo – 22-16 after taking a solid early lead and fighting back on the last three ends after being challenged.

Vicky Walker with Pat Carr, Norm Draper & Joan Chamberlain -14-20 - it didn't matter whether we held 1, 2, 3 or even 5 shots on a changeover, the opposition Skip took everything away with a mixture of brilliance (and occasional luck) for much of the day.

Joe Farsaci with Noel Greig, John Pater & Derek Jarvis – 23-12 after taking a strong lead and fighting off any serious challenge.

Aberfeldie 3, playing Away (and short) at Princes Park, suffered a 46-70 loss for 3 points. Rink results:

Gerry Carr with Amanda McOrmond, Graham Govan & Nigel Thompson - 17-17 on a Rink that could not have finished closer.

Mid –week Pennant

Two strong wins on Tuesday sees Aberfeldie 1 on top of the ladder and Aberfeldie 2 in second ladder position as Mid-week Pennant goes into the Christmas break. Aberfeldie 1 had a comfortable 48-32 win at Moonee Ponds and Aberfeldie 2 had a similarly comfortable 45-28 win at Home. Aberfeldie 1 defeated Moonee Ponds 48- 32 for the full 14 points. Rink results:

Sean Lee was once again a sterling volunteer in helping to set up for the packing, the packing itself - and on hand early on Tuesday morning to assist the Nurses in loading up.
