Weekend Pennant Divisional Semi Final – one that got away!!

Aberfeldie 3

Played at Glenroy on Saturday in very good, but hot conditions, and all looked set for a solid win with a 39-20 overall lead against Club Bridgewater after thirty ends. An afternoon Break a few ends later saw a remarkable turnaround across the rest of the game, with Club Bridgewater fighting back strongly to take the overall win by 9 shots (59-68). Rink results:

Nigel Thompson, with Barry Baguley, Graham Govan, & George Pater - 19-19 after going out to an early 15-3 lead at eleven ends, we then dropped away badly (including one "6" shot end loss) - and had to scramble to get things back to a tie at game's end.

Graham Leydin, with Carmen Ritter, Gavin Thoms & Greg French -9-39 on a Rink where we kept things tight early, but the loss of a "6" on the seventh end saw the rot set in, to the point we lost every one of the last ten ends - conceding 26 shots in the process.

Albert Considine, with John Williams, John Mutch & GERRY CARR – 31-10 and the only one of our Rinks to hold it together for the full game. Excellent effort from Albert and his Rink to concede just six ends for the game.

A very disappointing loss after a great half game performance. Club Bridgewater comfortably won its Semi-final against Blackburn North on Sunday and goes through to the Divisional Grand Final against MCC.

Mid-week Pennant - Sectional Grand Final (and we are a "Winner")

Our excellent Semi-final wins saw Aberfeldie 1 face off against Aberfeldie 2 at Clifton Park in last Thursday's Six-a-Side Sectional Grand Final. In a very competitive game, Aberfeldie 2 looked like taking a win on one Rink, while on the other Aberfeldie 1 held sway from early on and held off something of a challenge over the closing ends. The final result, Aberfeldie 1 taking an 11-shot win (41-30) to seal the Sectional Championship, with Aberfeldie 2 as Runner Up. Rink results: Aberfeldie 1 (Manny Flores, with Clay Beveridge & Lynne Grogan) defeated Aberfeldie 2 (Sam Folino, with Joe Scifo & Murray Whiteway – 18-16 after looking rattled early when trailing by 5 shots, the Aberfeldie 1 Skip took a strategic Break, following which his Rink regrouped to win five of the last seven ends – and take the game with a 2 shot margin.

Aberfeldie 1 (John Grogan, with Barry Baguley & Sean Lee) defeated Aberfeldie 2 (Albert Considine, with Bill Walshe & Gabriele Forlani) – 23-14 after getting out to an early 10 shot lead before Aberfeldie tightened things up without closing the gap.
