<u>Aberfeldie 1</u> – (Match report from Michael Bialczak)

Aberfeldie 1 got back to winning ways again, against a determined Gladstone Park. We definitely started off better this week and were over 20 shots ahead a third of the way through, then 48-32 up at the halfway point. Gladstone Park rallied in the next 5 ends to get within 8 shots before we pulled away again to win 84-66, for 16 points. The top 3 teams won, with 3rd place Craigieburn just holding off 4th placed Werribee by 1 shot. So, the standings are Moonee Ponds 123, Aberfeldie 116 in Second, Craigieburn 107, with 4th place being fought over by four teams, led by Werribee on 77. The first game back in January will be a tough game against Doutta Galla at their home, after they beat Strathmore comfortably.

Ian Ferretter, Don Leale, Endre Rakosi, Lorenzo di Sipio 18-13. A bit of a slow start again by Ian's team, but fought back quickly, got to 10-7 up after 11 ends and kept them at bay the rest of the day.

John Grogan, Nigel Thompson, Wayne Harper, Stuart O'Brien 22-16. Early on, it seemed like last week's game was going to be repeated as the opposition Skipper kept on getting wicks to take away winning shots. But with enough good bowls on the head, the tide turned and we lead 12-10 after 11 ends and drew away in the 2nd half.

Manny Flores, Lyn Grogan, Paul Ives, Sam Folino 28-15. Started off with a bang, 7-0 up, then 12-4 before Gladstone Park rallied to 12-10 after 11 ends. However, with Sam and Paul consistently putting great bowls in the head, Gladstone Park finally cracked and we outscored them 16-5 in the last 10 ends for a big win.

Sean Lee, Frank Piccolo, Murray Whiteway, Michael Bialczak 16-22. Started off really well, being 12-4 up after 11 ends. Then the opposition Skipper put on a masterclass and we could only win 2 of the last 10 ends. There were three ends where we were holding shot before their skipper got a favourable wick to take shot. But he also played some classy draws, the best example being the last end, where we held 5 shots within half a metre. He was able to land right on one of our front bowls to take the shot.
